Abstract: This paper aims to provide a critical edition of the *Quaestiones in Primum Sententiarum*, dist. 36 of the English Franciscan Master William of Alnwick († 1333). This text contains Alnwick's opinion on divine ideas he held in Paris in 1313-1314, a position he partially changed in the *Quaestiones disputatae de esse intelligibili* (Oxford, 1316-1317).
